


Indian Valley Family YMCA summer day camps

This summer is bringing new and exciting changes to the Indian Valley Family YMCA's summer camps. As we began to review our highlights from summer 2016 we found that we needed to up our game in several areas. Most importantly we need to improve our communication with parents, families and campers in the months and weeks leading up to camp as well as during the camp season. We aim to improve this communication by streamlining our registration process, have additional newsletters, provide in session email and notices, and have counselors available during the sign in and sign out process. We have also added a 9th week of full day camp at both Yankee Trails and Indian Valley.



Camp IV program camps

Program camps are Camp Indian Valley's version of specialty camps. These camps are designed to have the campers explore, grow, and discover whole new worlds while having fun. All camps are age specific and are designed with the camper in mind. Choose a Program Camp and watch your imagination soar!

All camps are \$230 unless otherwise noted.

CREATIVE CAMPERS grades 1-3

Geared for the younger campers, this camp will focus on arts and crafts. Kids explore a variety of projects such as: clay sculpture, sketching, watercolors or paints, nature collages, paper mâché, picture frames, necklaces, bracelets, and so much more. Campers create masterpieces to take home and enjoy!
