LEAGUE FORMAT

Games will be officiated by YMCA employed referees. All games will take place on Mondays. Players will all receive a T Shirt on the night of the first game. Be sure to read policies below.

LEAGUE PHILOSOPHY

- YMCA Basketball Leagues are designed to stress independence, skill development, participation, leadership, sportsmanship, and fun.
- Teams are formed by captains. Any participant can be a captain; they are to contact the Sr. Program Director before the season start. Spots are limited. Playing time should be equal but managed by the captains.
- Refs strive to ensure every player plays an equitable amount of time each game. All players and captains participating in this league are expected to participate within YMCA guidelines.
- Every player is required to sign a code of conduct.
- If players are found breaking this code they will be subject to consequences and possible suspension from the league.
- At the Y we strive to develop character and promote values such as Caring, Honesty, Respect, Responsibility, Teamwork, Sportsmanship, and fun.

REFUND POLICY

A full refund or credit will be provided if a written cancellation is provided prior to the <u>second scheduled game</u> of the season. Following the second game, refunds are only provided for medical reasons with a physicians note.
